



1 Aruba DTZ

The Directie Telecommunicatie Zaken (DTZ) of Aruba has changed the certificate validity from permanent into 5 years, which came in force from July 1st, 2021.

2 Brazil ANATEL

ANATEL has released Act 77 in January 2021, which is effective. Act 77 is about cybersecurity requirements for equipment with Internet connection. Manufacturers and Applicants have to submit a declaration letter, declares that the equipment meets basic cybersecurity requirements as defined in Act 77 for ANATEL's review.

3 Mexico IFETEL

IFETEL of Mexico has released new requirement for the Conformity Assessment Procedures (CAP, also known as PEC) for Telecommunications and Broadcasting. IFT will not accept applications without the following statements in manuals:

“La operación de este equipo está sujeta a las siguientes dos condiciones:

- (1) Es posible que este equipo o dispositivo
- (2) Este equipo o dispositivo debe aceptar cualquier interferencia. Incluyendo la que pueda causar su operación no deseada.”

4 New Zealand RSM

Radio Spectrum Management in New Zealand has released an update Table of Radio Spectrum Usage (PIB 21). Which includes updating from ITU Radio Regulations as modifications on the 1700-2300MHz and 3.5GHz bands.

Sierra Leone NATCOM

NATCOM of Sierra Leone has issued labeling requirement for type approval certification. According to Section 9 (2) of Electronic Communications Type Approval Regulations 2020, every supplier, importer, distributor or seller shall, where applicable, ensure that equipment offered for sale or for private use clearly has a type approval label containing the following:

- ✓ The logo
- ✓ The product type/ category
- ✓ A unique Type Approval Number (YYYY-PCN-UTAN)

YYYY= Year of Certification (4 digits)

PCN= Product Category Number (3 digits)

UTAN= Unique Type Approval Number (4 digits)

Saudi Arabia CITC and SASO

The Communications and Information Technology Commission (CITC) of Saudi Arabia has updated the technical specifications for communications and information technology equipment and devices. Which includes General/ Navigation/ Wired and Wireless Communication/ Mobile Communication/ Short Range Wireless Communication/ Broadcasting, the updated technical specifications came in force from July 20th, 2021.

The Saudi Standards, Metrology and Quality Organization (SASO) announced to postpone the implement date of IEC 62368-1:2018 from July 1st, 2021 to January 1st, 2023. The last date receiving IEC 62368:2014 extended to December 30th, 2022.

Russia GOST-R and EAC

Updated news in June : From June 21st, 2021, a new GOST-R logo should be used (CTP logo).

The certificate **issued before June 21st, 2021** need to use “PCT logo” **till the certification validity ends**.

There is no dimension of CTP logo yet, only the drawing for reference.

According to Decree No. 936 on June 19th, 2021, extended the effective date till September 1st for GLN (Global Location Number) requirement of EAC DoC.

8 Samoa

The Administration of Samoa has issued Order of the Regulator No. 2021/T02, requesting manufacturers and importers should label telecommunications equipment with the Samoa compliance mark upon receiving a Type Approval Certificate from the Regulator, which came in force on June 23, 2021.

9 Serbia CoC

The Ministry of Economy published Official Gazette of the RS, No. 21/2020 about EMC and LVD Rulebook Amendments. Main changes is that Serbian EMC and LVD Certificates of Conformity (CoC) will no longer be required from January 1st, 2022. CE marking will be acceptable for non-radio equipment to demonstrate compliance. Until this date, manufacturers should continue to meet the current requirements (EMC and LVD CoC).
