



### 1 Thailand NBTC & TISI

NBTC (The National Broadcasting and Telecommunications Commission) of Thailand has released new standard (NBTC TS 1038-2564) for the use of unmanned aerial vehicles in the 24.05-24.25GHz band. The new standard came in forced on March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Applicable standard ETSI EN 300 440 V2.2.1 for Class A scheme application, output power must not exceed 100 mW e.i.r.p.

The Thai Industrial Standards Institute (TISI) has released new standard TIS 1195-2561: Audio, Video, and Similar Electronic Apparatus – Safety Requirements on March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021, which would be effected 180 days after released (Aug. 29<sup>th</sup>, 2021).

Main changes as below:

- Replace TIS 1195-2536
- Applies for audio and video products. Tentative products that under mandatory standard will be TV sets, speakers, game consol and its power supply adapter. (not yet concluded other product category)

### 2 South Korea KC Safety

The Korean Agency for Technology and Standards (KATS) has included Cell and Rechargeable coin-shape type battery products into mandatory list. From Jan. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021, Soft-case type battery which over 4.4V and 700Wh/L would also need to apply KC Safety Certificate.

## South Africa NRCS

The National Regulator for Compulsory Specifications (NRCS) in South Africa has announced that national compulsory specification VC 8055 will recognize SANS/IEC 62368-1 as an equivalent standard to SANS/IEC 60065 and SAN/IEC 60950 from April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021. Although, VC 8055 has not updated and included SANS/IEC 62368-1 at the moment.
