



### 1 Brazil ANATEL

ANATEL has released following Regulations:

Act 1306 has released on Feb. 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021, which updates Act 14448/2017 to include the Wi-Fi 6E (5,925MHz to 7,125MHz) technical requirements.

Act 1477 has released on March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021. This Act establishes the technical requirements for the use of the spectrum by devices operating in the frequency range from 3,300 MHz to 3,700 MHz (5G NR band n78). This Act will be effected from April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021.

Act 1630 has released on March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021, which replaces the previous Act 955 about the SAR evaluation test procedures for Telecommunication products.

- Change the applicable frequency range from 300MHz- 6GHz to 4MHz-6GHz
- Fully adopted IEC/IEEE 62209-1528 (2020), for the evaluation of portable terminal stations operating in the radio frequency bands between 4MHz and 6GHz.

### 2 Mexico IFETEL

On March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2021, IFETEL has published the Public Consult for Preliminary Draft of the update for the technical Operational conditions of 57-64GHz, mainly as below:

### 3 Bahrain TRA

The Directorate of Wireless Licensing, Frequency & Monitoring (DWLF&M) and the Telecommunication Regulatory Authority (TRA) in Bahrain will be merged and type approvals will be issued by TRA.

All the merging details has not been confirmed, but TRA already started issuing type approval certificates for the products used to be In DWLF&M.



### 4 Vietnam MIC

Vietnam MIC has released draft QCVN 127 : 2021 / BTTTT for National Technical Regulation on 5G Mobile communication terminal equipment, expected to be effected on August 15, 2021.

After effected, all the 5G devices need to meet QCVN 127 : 2021 / BTTTT.

### 5 Saudi Arabia SIRC

Saudi Standards, Metrology and Quality Organization, SASO has released a list of new products that will require IECEE Recognition Certificate (SIRC) from July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021.

The list as below:

- Electrical pumps (5HP and below)
- Coffee makers and Coffee making machines
- Electric Fryers
- Electrical Cables
- Video games and accessories
- Electric water kettles

Reminder, from July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021, Saudi Arabia only accepts CB standard IEC 62368-1:2018 (edition 3) report and cert. For the certificate still valid, will not be affected.

## Israel MoC

Israel MoC has released an exemption list from MoC type approval.

The complete list as below:

- Products operating within the frequency band 2400 to 2483.5 MHz in Bluetooth technology according to the IEEE 802.15.1 standard, or in ANT / ANT + technology, which includes a built-in antenna, and their power does not exceed 100 milliwatts EIRP;
- Products designed only for receiving satellite positioning transmissions using a global positioning system such as GALILEO, GLONASS, GPS or BEIDOU;
- Products with a parabolic antenna not exceeding 244 cm in diameter, including the ancillary equipment used by it, intended for the reception of satellite transmissions;
- Products operating in the field of infrared frequencies between 1GHz and 3GHz and whose transmission power does not exceed 200 milliwatts;
- Computer peripherals (mouse, keyboard);
- Computer monitors;
- Video streamers (Streamer), which comply with the provisions of the European Directive Radio Equipment Directive 2014/53/EU and bear the CE marking indicating this;
- E-book readers
- Tablets
- Laptops or notebook computers;
- Desktop computers
- Converters for receiving TV broadcasts to the public (TV receiver set-top box), which meets the provisions of the European Radio Equipment Directive 2014/53/EU and it bears the CE marking indicating this;
- TV sets and tuners;
- Radio receivers for receiving public broadcasts using such technologies AM/DAB/FM
- Spare parts for mobile phones;
- Wristwatches, other than cellular wristwatches;
- Vacuum Cleaners;
- Portable battery-operated metal detector.
